Kean College of New Jersey

The following agreement relative to the course "Adventures in Ideas" (I.D. 4900) was reached on April 30, 1975, between representatives of the KCFT and the College Administration.

Advisory Committee

I. Structure

- A. The Committee shall consist of fourteen (14) members. The members will elect one of their number as Chairman.
- B. The term of office of each committee member, with the exception of the first year, shall be two years.
- C. Committee composition:
  - 1. Faculty - 9
    - a. School of Arts and Sciences - 6
      - Humanities - 2
      - Mathematics and Science - 2
      - Social Sciences - 2
    - b. School of Education - 3
  - 2. Students - 2
    - a. Full-time - 1
    - b. Part-time - 1
  - 3. Office of Dean of Students - 1
  - 4. Office of College Development - 1
  - 5. Office of Instructional Resource Center - 1

E. Each departmental representative shall be elected by the members of the department following procedures formulated by the Departmental Personnel Relations Committee.

II. Responsibility of Advisory Committee

A. Personnel Policies (Terms and conditions of employment)

1. Announcement to Faculty of teaching opportunities available.
2. Develop criteria for Faculty selection
3. Select Faculty
4. Select Coordinator
5. Faculty members will be compensated at the contractual overload rate for three (3) teaching credit hours.
6. The Coordinator has the responsibility for the organization and administration of the course, "Adventures in Ideas," and will report to the Dean of the School of Arts and Sciences in these matters as well as in matters affecting Faculty scheduling and overload contracts.

**II. Responsibility of Advisory Committee**


**B. Suggested Academic Functions**

1. Develop yearly theme
2. Suggest speakers
3. Develop evaluation procedures
4. Receive annual report from the Coordinator by May 15 of each year.
5. Submit annual progress report to the Academic Standards Committee and the College Curriculum Committee.

**III. General Considerations**

- A. The responsibility of the Advisory Committee will be to implement matters affecting Faculty terms and conditions of employment as well as the suggested academic functions.
- B. The restructuring of the Advisory Committee is designed to: (1) broaden the base of faculty participation; (2) provide for the democratic selection of faculty representatives; (3) provide for a rotating departmental representation.
- C. In order to provide continuity, six of the departments currently represented are continued on the Advisory Council for the 1975-1976 academic year. It is the sincere hope that the Faculty presently representing these departments will again be selected as their departmental representative.


