LETTER OF AGREEMENT # 82

The Kean College Administration and the Kean College Federation of Teachers have agreed that in terms of the composition and procedures used for the purpose of recommending Retention and Tenure at the School level for faculty members within the newly established School of Government, Business, and Technology, for the academic year 1987-1988, the School Retention and Tenure committee structures and procedures will remain the same as existed during the academic year 1986-1987. Therefore, the departments within School of Government, Business, and Technology will forward recommendations as follows:

1. The Retention and Tenure Committees of the Departments of Management Science/Economics and Political Science will continue to forward their recommendations for faculty reappointments to the School of Liberal Arts Retention and Tenure Committee (formerly the School of Humanities, Social and Administrative Sciences). Each candidate will receive written notification of this recommendation.
2. The Retention and Tenure Committee of the Department of Technology will continue to forward its recommendations for faculty reappointments to the School of Education Retention and Tenure Committee (formerly the School of Education, Technology and Related Professions). Each candidate will receive written notification of this recommendation.
3. The faculty members from the Management Science/Economics Department, the Political Science Department, and the Technology Department elected to serve on the School Retention and Tenure Committee for the academic year 1987-1988 will serve on the appropriate existing School Committee.
4. The Acting Dean of the School of Government, Business and Technology will also sit on the two existing School Retention and Tenure Committees and serve as co-chairperson with the respective School Dean during the academic year 1987-1988.

It is understood that this is an agreement for the academic year 1987-1988 only. Beginning with the academic year 1988-1989, the School of Government, Business, and Technology will establish its own Retention and Tenure Committee which will provide for the appropriate faculty representation from each department within the school.
