C. Promotion 1. Promotion of Faculty Members

a. General Guidelines (9)

Change paragraph (9) as follows:

(9) Applications and recommendations on behalf of a candidate for promotion are submitted to Departmental ARTP Committees. The Departmental committee will send private written notification to each person who has submitted an application, whether recommended for promotion or not. Any

person not recommended may request a hearing by the Committee. If the

Committee decides not to reverse an unfavorable decision, it will send to

the individual, at his request, a statement of its reasons for such a decision.

If the committee does not recommend promotion, such notification will include

written reasons for the decision. Any person not recommended may request a

hearing by the committee. Notification and reasons will be provided in time

to allow for such a hearing. Following the hearing the committee will again

vote on the application. Applicants will be provided private written

notification of the results. Persons may then appeal to the College

Promotion Committee, which will follow a similar order of procedure. All

of the above shall adhere to the promotion sequence and the annual schedule

as published by the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
